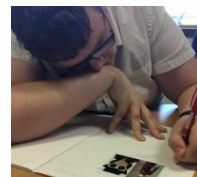


OSPREY pupils have been learning about Fairtrade chocolate and have been reading Willy Wonka and the Chocolate
