We use Class Dojo to celebrate learning and also to inform you of events that are happening across the school, including your child's class. You will need an invite password to access our Class Dojo, please let your child's teacher know and they will send it home.

**PHONICS**

Mr Roberts, our English Lead, has been very busy sorting out our All Aboard Phonics App for pupils, staff and families to use. As Mr Roberts explained on Class Dojo, over the next few days, you will get an invite to download and sign up for the app - All Aboard Phonics.

With this app, you will be able to support your child's reading and they will be able to access games and phonics books to support their reading development at home. As this is brand new for school, Mr Roberts will be putting some instruction videos on Dojo in the future.
