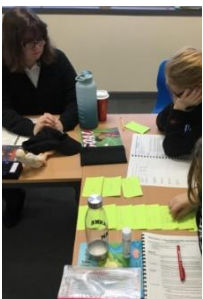
Yorkshire Wildlife Park
