### Administering of prescribed medications in school

With effect from Monday 29 April 2024 we will be trialling a paperless system to collect parental consent to administer prescribed medication in school. You will be required to complete an electronic consent form before sending your child into school with any **newly prescribed** medication. **Important!** Please note that staff will not be allowed to administer medication to your child until your completed electronic form has been received. Whenever possible please submit the form **before** your child arrives at school with their medication. The above QR code will be permanently available on our website and by using this link, you will be able to access the consent form at any time.

**Please note that this applies to newly prescribed medication only. You do not need to contact school if you have an existing paper consent form in place.**

Could we also please remind parents/carers that all medications must be passed to the escort/driver on transport. It is very important that any medication sent in to school is transferred adult to adult.
